Teachers to work alongside sports coaches, where possible, to team teach and learn through their expertise.	Most teachers have had a minimum of two half terms CPD this year. Staff have identified the areas of PE they feel they need to develop and have had specialist coached training to strengthen these areas.

Coaches to inspire children to undertake after school and lunch time sport clubs; more children will participate in competitive and non-competitive physical activity.	Children continue to have access to four clubs, two after school and two lunch time: football for UKS2/ LKS2, Multi-sports club Increased number of children actively involved in physically active structured activities at lunchtime that did not/ could not attend after school clubs.

A request has now been made to have one installed on the Yr3/4 playground which we are looking into, ground work required first.  The donated basketball hoop is regularly in use and has increased the number of children taking part in this sport. Interest in basketball increased following Basketball demonstration day- we are now looking at buying two free standing basketball posts for the Yr3/4 playground.</p>
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
