- ✓ Contribution towards TA salaries for work with vulnerable pupils
- ✓ Attendance Prizes
- ✓ Contribution towards specialist teacher of Mathematics targeting Gifted and Talented pupils
- ✓ To provide extra SENCO hours to support the most vulnerable pupils
- ✓ Behaviour support for vulnerable children with particular needs
- ✓ Payments for vulnerable children for holiday club activities
- ✓ An art project with our local ArtSpace Project Group
- ✓ Extra Activities to encourage children's participation to contribute to positive mental health.
- ✓ To pay for an extra MDS to engage pupils in play.
- ✓ To pay for two apprentice TAs to enable experienced TAs to spend more time directly with the pupils.
